

National Program Evaluation (NPE) of the CNP Program

The final program evaluation of the CNP is developed by the Program Directors, PIs, and NPE contractor.

- Critical areas of consideration:
 - Evaluation plan
 - Core data elements
 - Implementation of plan
- Purpose of program evaluation
 - Designed to measure how well goals and objectives of the RFA are being attained and met.

National Program Evaluation

- NPE Contractor role – Work with CRCHD and CNP PIs
 - Collect the data necessary to make these assessments
 - Perform quality control and data monitoring
 - Provide technical assistance for program evaluation

Individual CNP Program Evaluation

- Evaluation of CNP impact
 - Collect baseline data now, before CNP education, research, and training begins
 - Collect data at the individual level
 - Provide summary data to NPE
 - Evaluate individual CNP educational, research, and training activities
