

## Information Sheet: Visiting the National Library of Medicine

### Driving Directions & Security [add 15-20 minutes to your travel time]

- Enter the NIH campus at the South Dr. entrance off Rockville Pike. Detailed driving directions are available online at <http://www.nlm.nih.gov/psd/ref/guide/rrdirect.html>.
- Similar to airport security, the following security procedures are conducted at the NIH entrance:
  - ⇒ all cars are inspected upon entering the NIH campus;
  - ⇒ everyone who is 16 and older needs to bring and present one government-issued photo ID under yellow alert. [Two IDs are required under orange alert.]
  - ⇒ everyone is inspected with a handheld magnetometer;
  - ⇒ personal belongings, such as bags and purses, may be inspected; then
  - ⇒ each person is given an NIH visitor pass.

We advise you to travel light to the Library to expedite the security process.

### Direction to the Lister Hill Center (Bldg. 38A) and Parking

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• After the inspection, stay on South Dr. and enter the NIH campus.</li> <li>• At the stop sign, turn left onto Center Dr.</li> <li>• Follow Center Dr. to the Library, which is the last building on the right before the security gate.</li> <li>• Make a right into the Library's driveway (the last right turn you can make on Center Dr. and you will see a flag pole as well) where you can park. [Note: the parking meter takes only quarters. After 5:00 PM, visitors are invited to park at no charge in all parking areas.]</li> <li>• After parking, walk back to Center Drive and turn left, back tracking until you find the Medlars Dr. on the left.</li> <li>• Turn left onto Medlars Dr. and you will see a high-rise structure, which is the Lister Hill Center (38A). Your meeting will take place on the first floor of that building.</li> </ul>
