Study Design



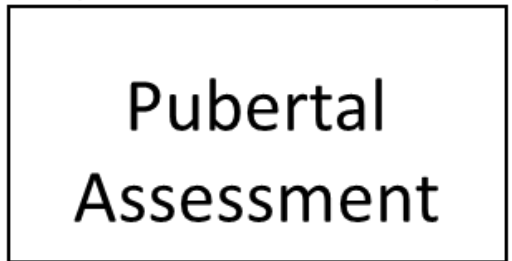
- **Population:** The LEGACY Girl's Study Cohort

 Blood Biospecimen Collected



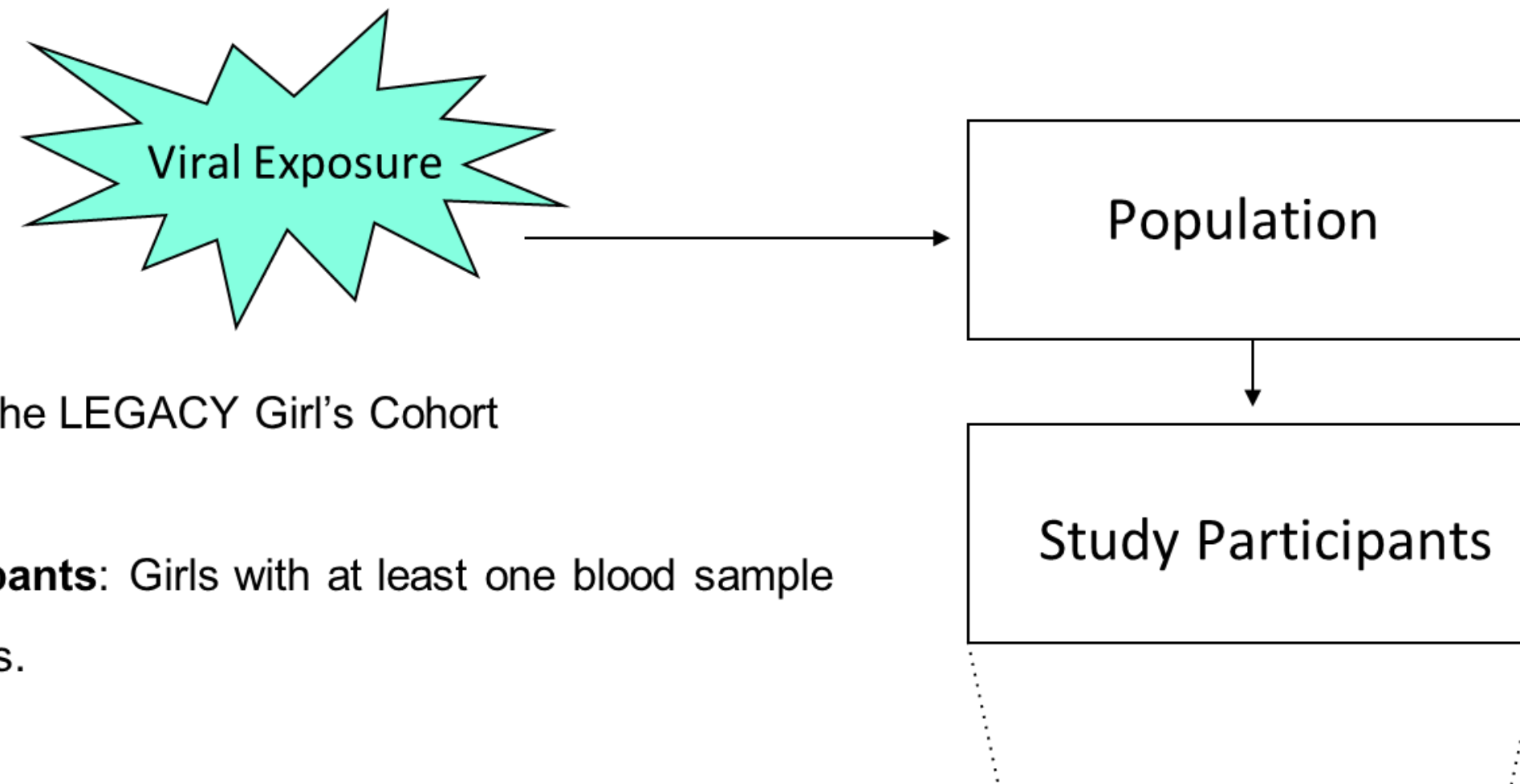

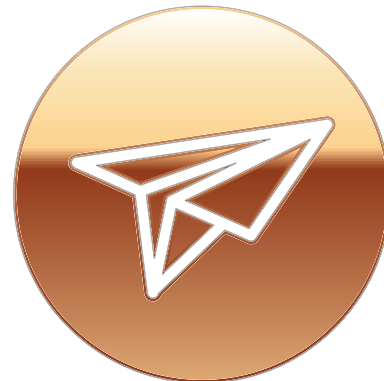

- **Population:** The LEGACY Girl's Cohort
- **Study Participants:** Girls with at least one blood sample prior to menses.

- **Viral Exposure: Seroprevalence Pilot on Common Childhood Viral Infections**



Pilot Objective: Examine distribution of Cytomegalovirus, Epstein Barr Virus, and Herpes Simplex Virus 1/2 in NY LEGACY (n=54)
 - HSV1 and HSV2 monoclonal antibodies became available post-pilot

Conclusions: Infections are measurable and prevalent in a contemporary cohort of girls, with prevalence similar to NHANES data.

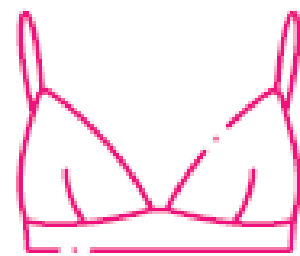

➤ Given viral infections can impact host biology differently, we created a categorical measure.

- No infection (Referent)
- CMV+ only
- CMV+ and EBV+ coinfection only
- EBV+ only

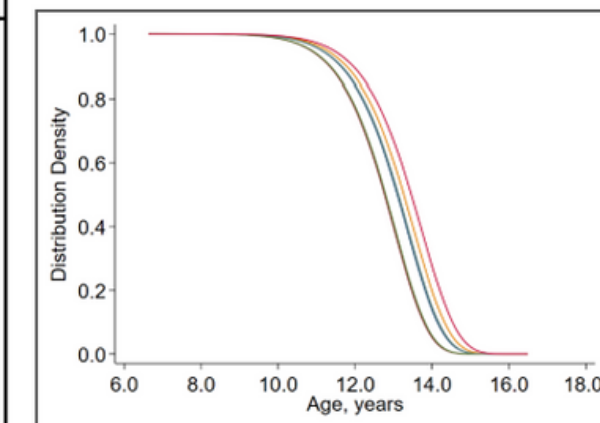
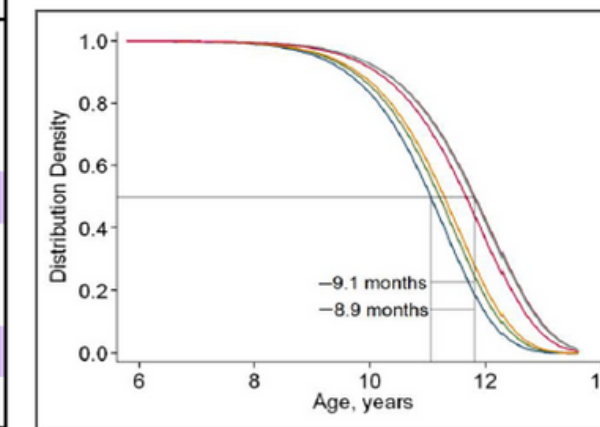
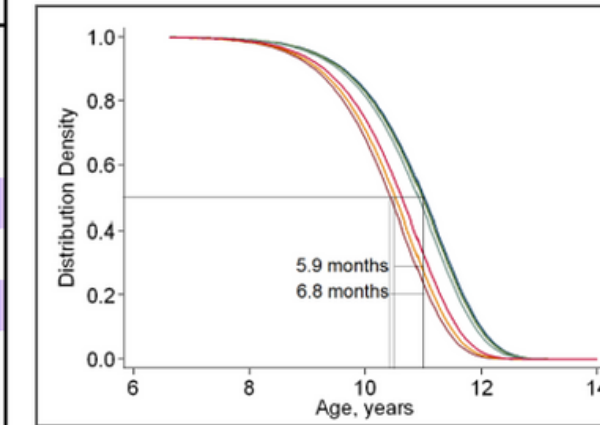

Viral Seroprevalence and Pubertal Timing

- First prospective study to demonstrate an association between common asymptomatic herpesviruses and pubertal development.
- CMV and HSV1/2 associated with later age at pubic hair development
- CMV associated with earlier age of breast development.

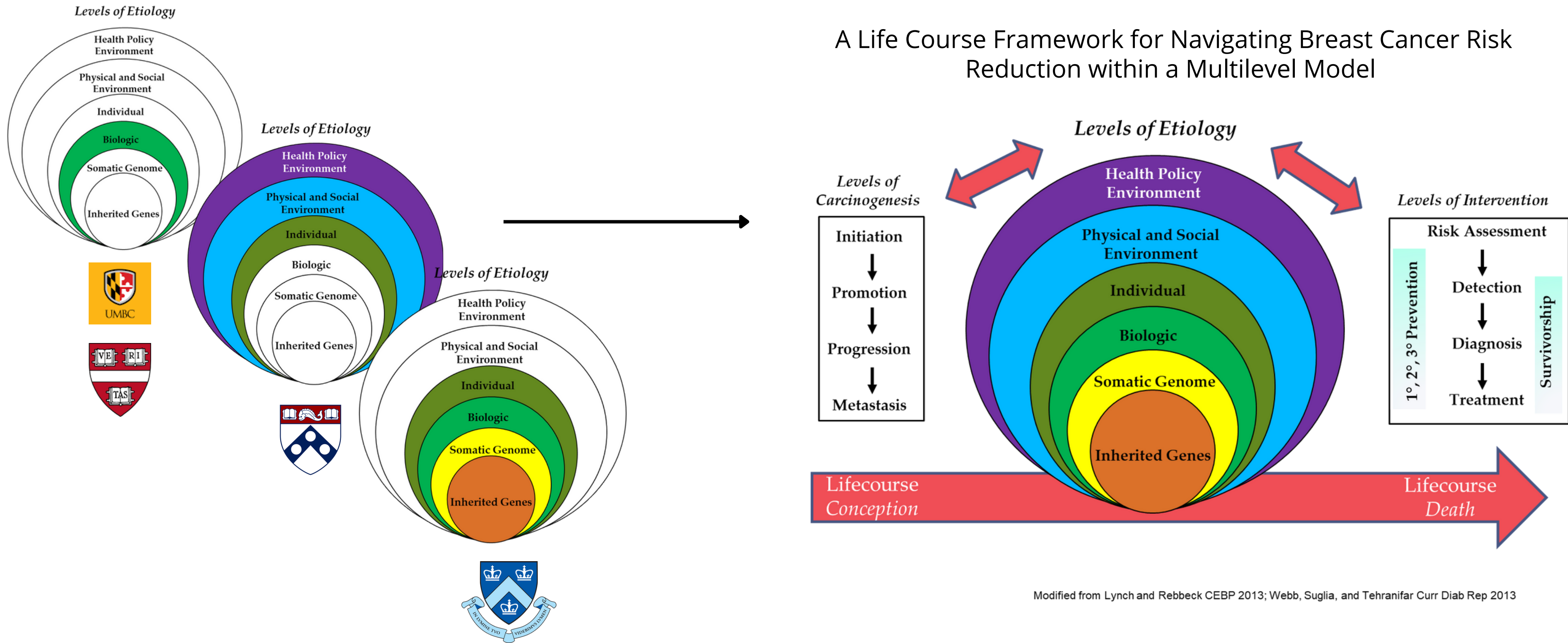

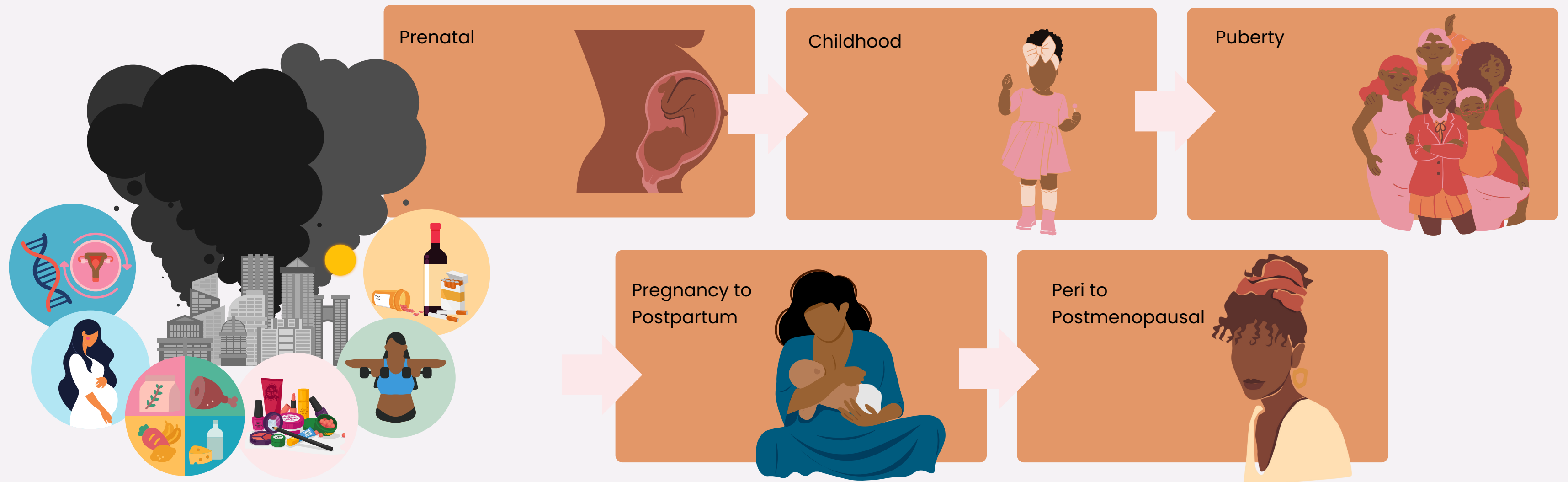
HRs were adjusted for age as the underlying time scale and the interaction between each viral measure as an indicator variable and the daughter's age, BMI percentile, BMI percentile*age. We present the most parsimonious models, excluding variables with P>0.05.

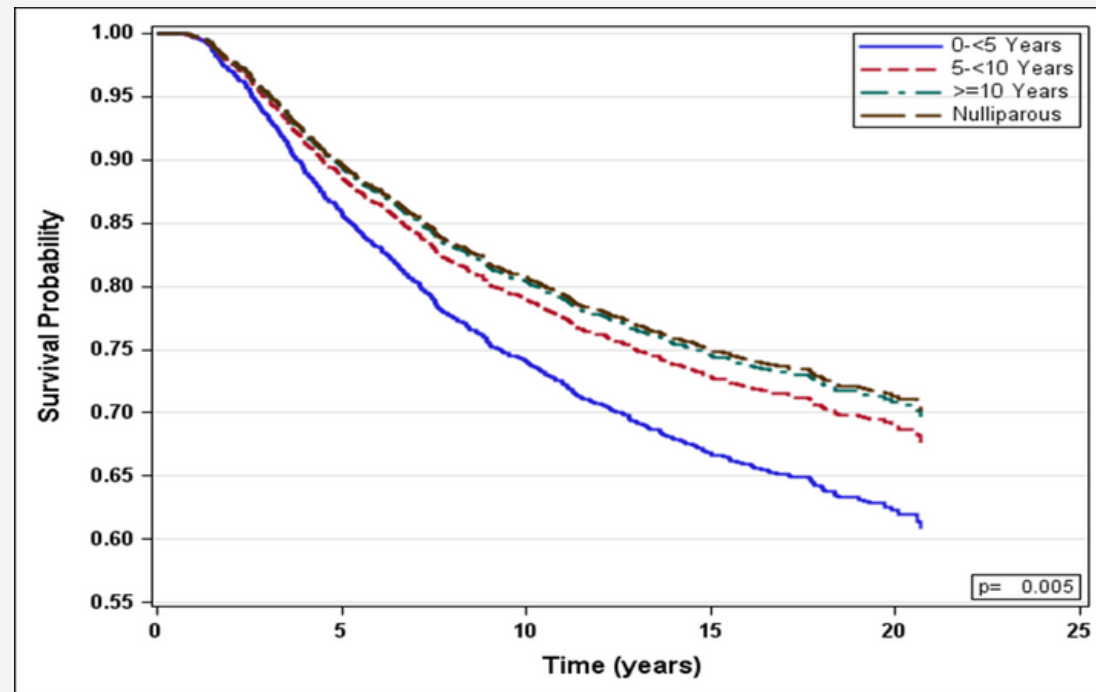

Overall Survival by Years Since Last Full-Term Pregnancy Prior to Breast Cancer Diagnosis, Adjusted for Age at Diagnosis

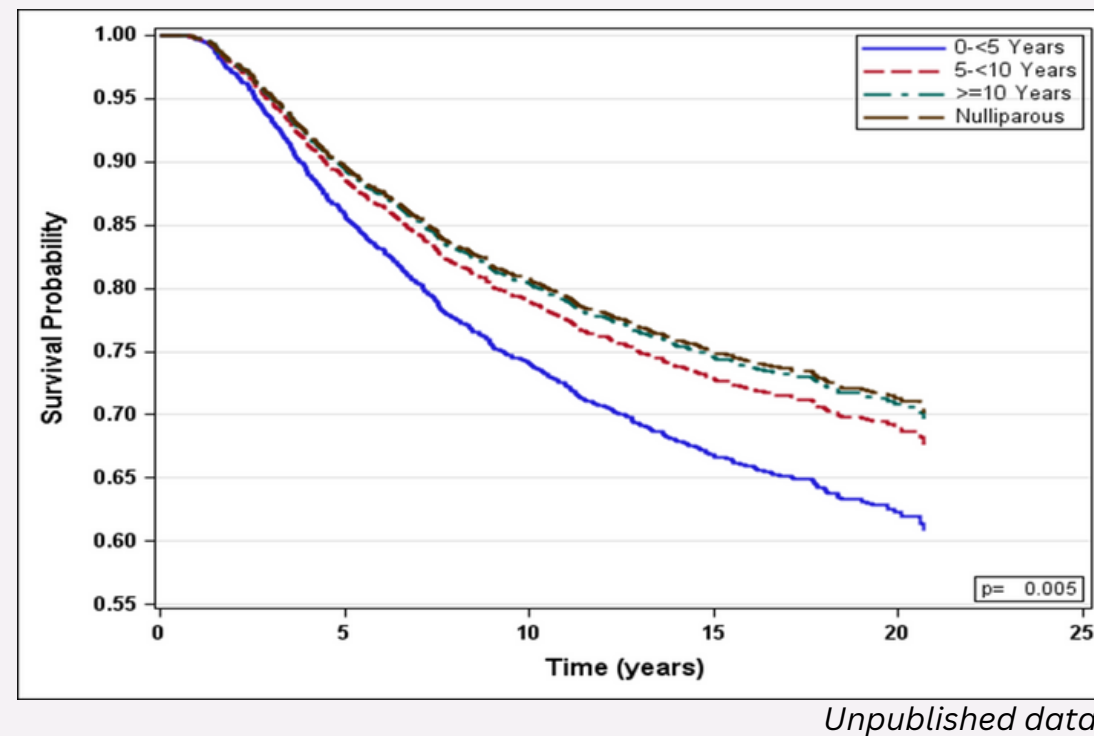

Overall Survival by Years Since Last Full-Term Pregnancy Prior to Breast Cancer Diagnosis, Adjusted for Age at Diagnosis

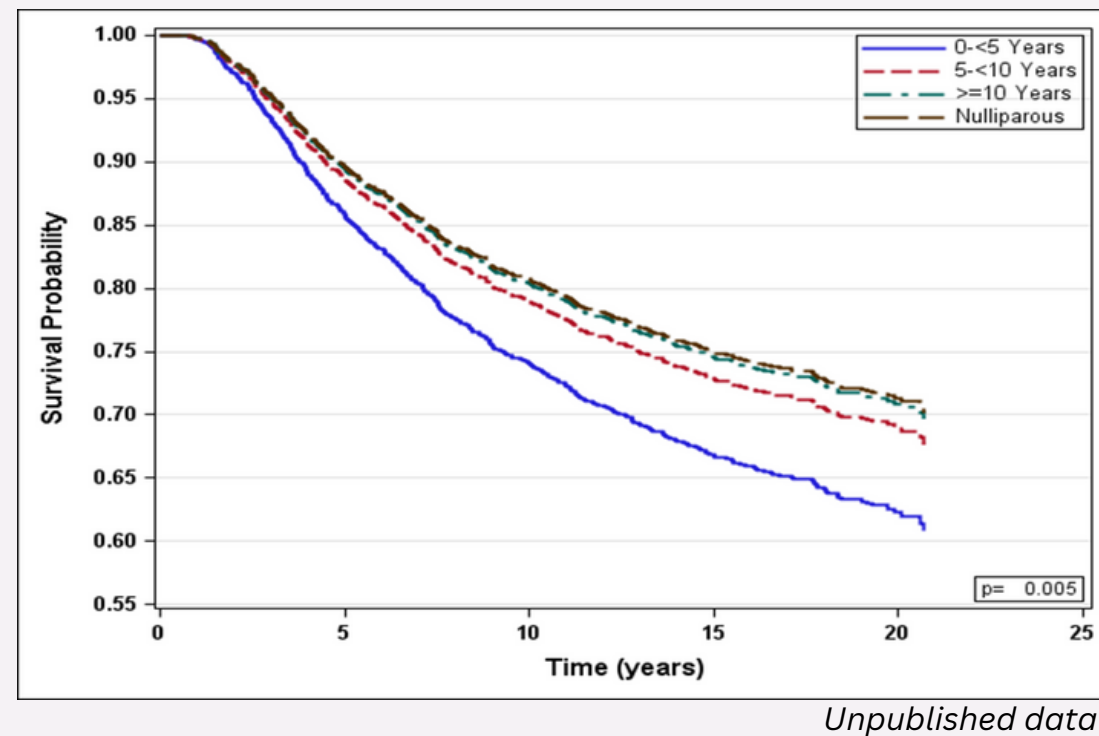

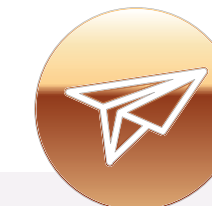
Overall Survival by Years Since Last Full-Term Pregnancy Prior to Breast Cancer Diagnosis, Adjusted for Age at Diagnosis



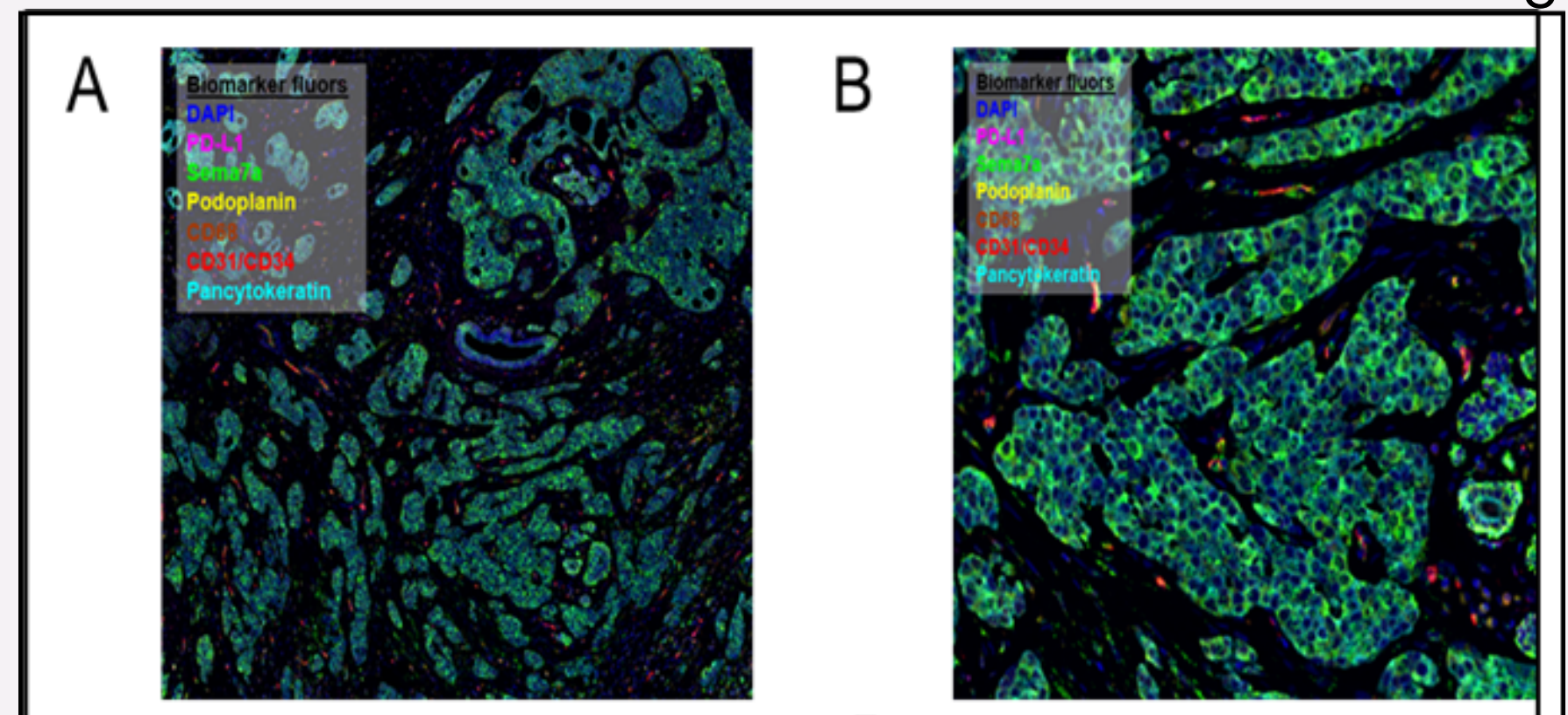

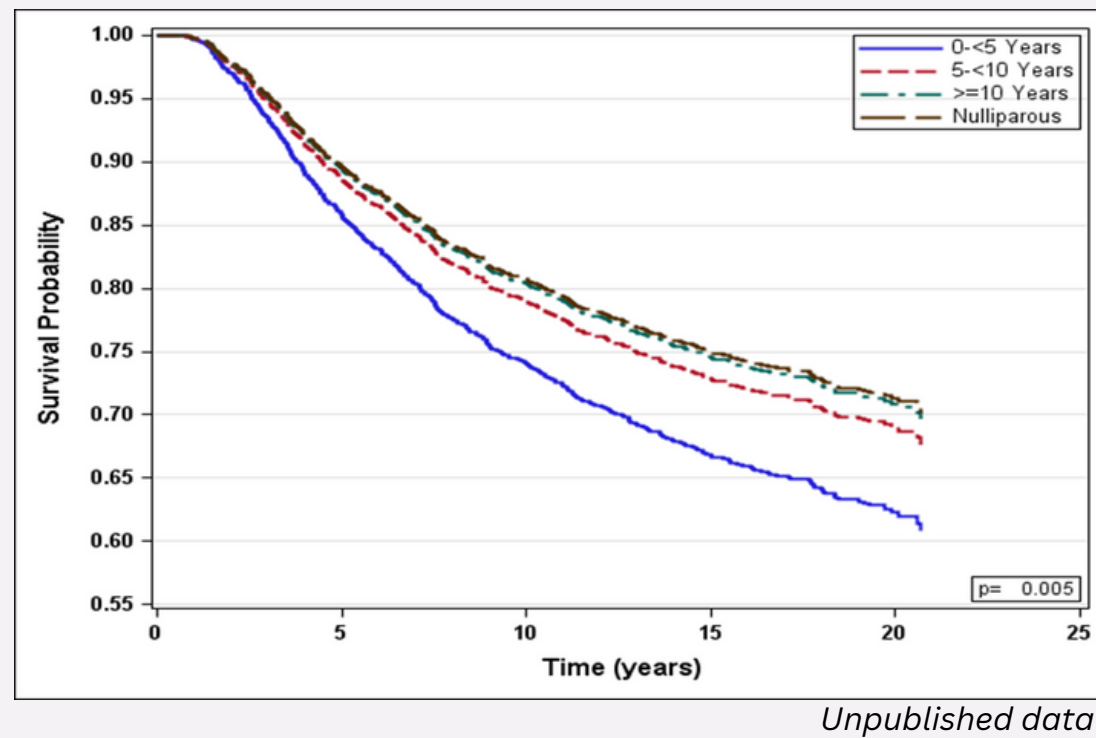

Overall Survival by Years Since Last Full-Term Pregnancy Prior to Breast Cancer Diagnosis, Adjusted for Age at Diagnosis



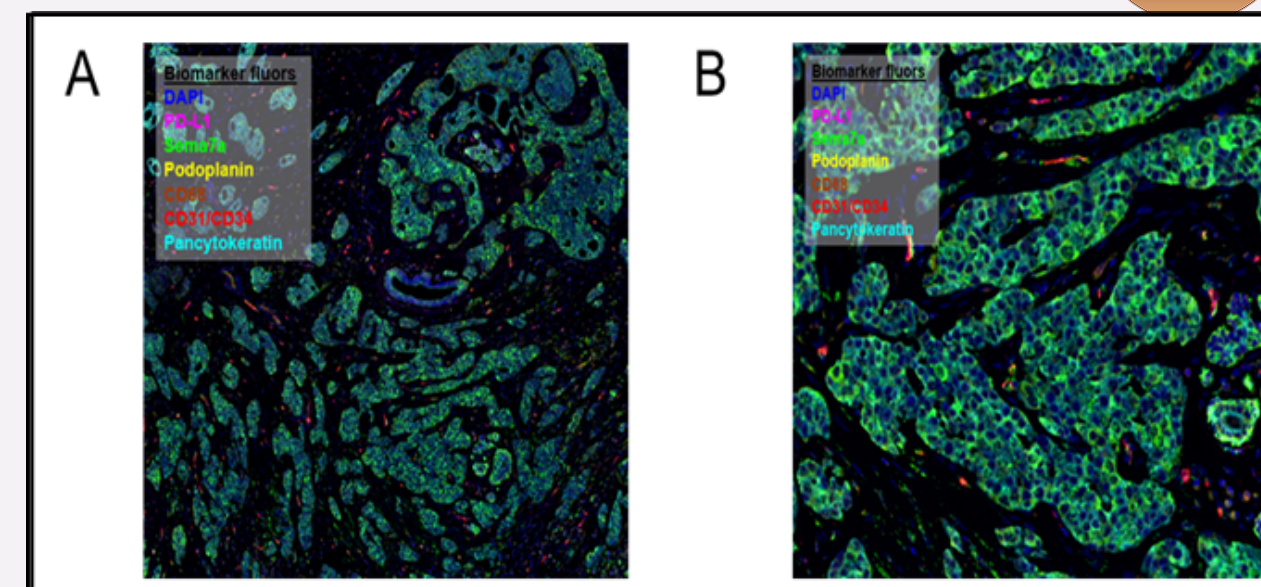
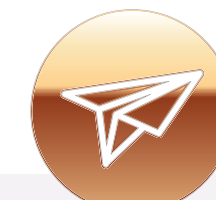

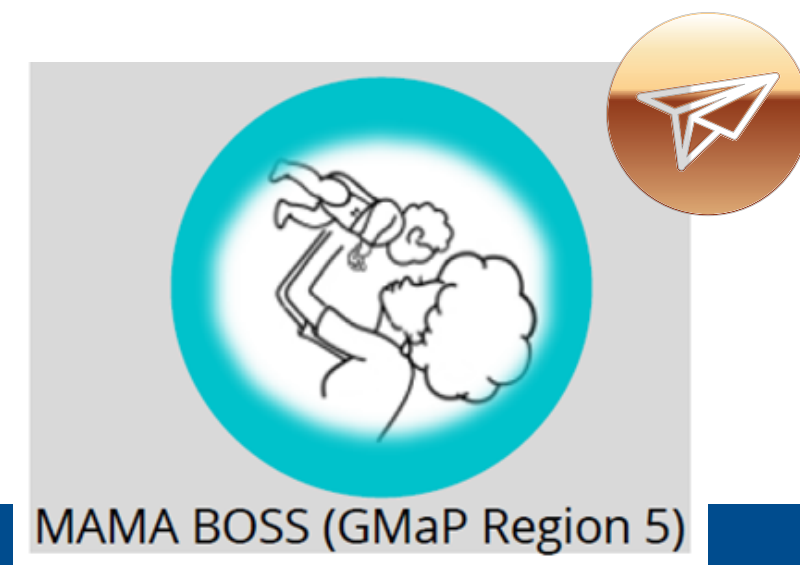


Embrace Criticism
