

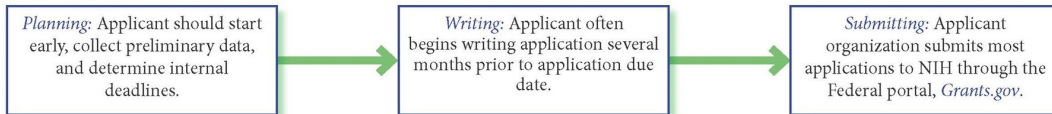
At-A-Glance



National Institutes of Health Grants Process At-A-Glance

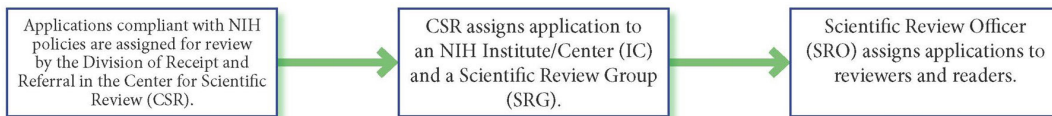

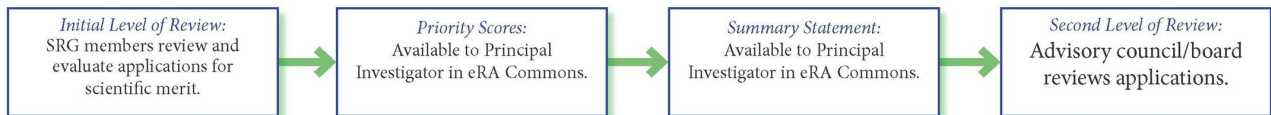
Receipt and Referral

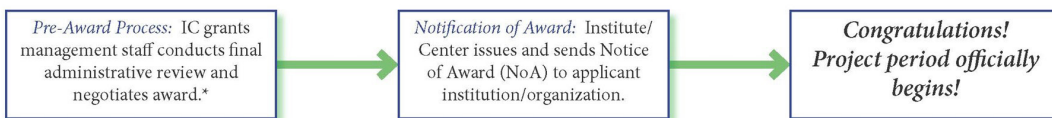

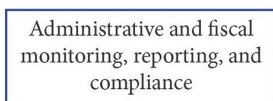

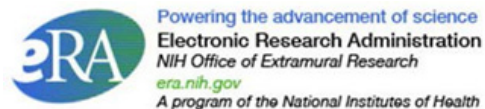
