# Academic Research Enhancement Award (AREA; REAP; R15) Grants

PAR-21-155 (Clinical Trial Not Allowed) and PAR-21-154 (Clinical Trial Required)

**AREA** grants support small-scale research projects in the biomedical and behavioral sciences conducted by faculty and students at educational institutions that are predominantly focused on undergraduate education and that have not been major recipients of NIH research grant funds.

**REAP** grants support small-scale research projects proposed by faculty members of eligible, domestic institutions to involve undergraduate and/or graduate students at health professional schools or graduate schools (that have not been major recipients of NIH research grant funds) in the conduct of meritorious research projects.

# MERIT Award (R37) Extension: The Request, Review, and Award Process

- The National Cancer Institute (NCI) Method to Extend Research in Time (MERIT) (R37) Award provides extended grant support to Early Stage Investigators (ESIs).
- By providing such an opportunity for longer term support to ESIs, the NCI intends to offer flexibility and opportunity for creativity and innovation and additional time to successfully launch their careers and to become more established before having to submit renewal applications (NOI-CA-180-037).
- The objective of the NCI's ESI MERIT Award is to allow eligible investigators the opportunity to obtain up to 7 years of support in two segments.
- The initial approved duration of the award.
- A 2-year extension.
